Wrexham County Borough

The numbers of live births in Wrexham have been quite variable but since 2003, they have been increasing steadily. In 2007, the Crude Birth Rate stood at 12.2, which was higher than the all Wales average of 11.6.

In the past decade, the annual number of deaths has regularly exceeded the number of live births, but since 2003 there has been an annual increase in the number of live births and now this easily outstrips deaths.
